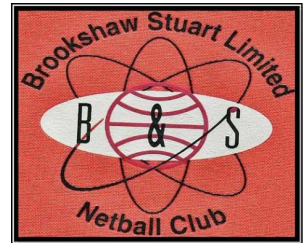


Brookshaw Stuart Junior Netball Club
